THE ILLINOIS CONFERENCE OF THE AAUP AND THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING CONGRESS OF THE AAUP

The Illinois Conference of the AAUP and the Collective Bargaining Congress of the AAUP will hold the first combined conference and annual meeting in the history of the Illinois Conference of the AAUP. The combined conference is open to all AAUP members and interested faculty. The combined meeting and conference will be held on Saturday April 30th, 2011 at the Crowne Plaza Metro, 733 West Madison Street, Chicago, Illinois from 9:30 am until 4:30 pm. Workshop sessions will focus on current issues such as Shared Governance, Academic Freedom, Advocacy, Chapter membership, legislative issues affecting higher education, the current state of adjunct faculty in Illinois and throughout the Nation, and graduate student organizing. In addition National AAUP officers will deliver key note addresses. The recent events in Wisconsin and other Midwestern states will be discussed. Each workshop will have a presenter from the Illinois Conference and the Collective Bargaining Congress. This combined approach will enhance the content of each workshop. Sessions will run about 50 minutes with time for questions and discussion.
